Life Membership Criteria and Nomination Process

Criteria for Nomination

Life membership of the OHF will be considered for any nominated person, past or present, that has demonstrated exceptional service to OHF over a long period of time.

Life membership will be considered when any combination of the following criteria has been rendered to OHF by an outstanding individual:

- Outstanding and sustained dedicated service to the Oceania Hockey Federation
- Conspicuous achievement in significant areas of endeavour, which enhanced hockey in the Oceania region
- OHF governance and administration of hockey enhancing growth, development and participation in the Oceania region

Note: Many people will do incredible work for hockey. However, life membership of OHF is awarded to a person who has achieved amazing results associated with direct work for the OHF.

Nomination Process and Confirmation of Award

A nomination should be sent to the Chief Executive Officer (ceo@oceania.hockey) by 31 August, for consideration at the Board's next board meeting.

The nomination will be considered by the OHF Board who will make a decision and a formal announcement and how best to recognise the recipient, with the recipient to be acknowledged at the next AGM.

Application Guidelines

Please consider the following points when making an application:

- Candidates name and contact information
- Why the candidate is a suitable candidate for life membership (max. 500 words)
- Current role and previous roles relevant to nomination
- Name and contact information of a suitable referee
